# **Cork Emergency Medicine**

#### **Truvada**

- Truvada is a combination of 2 drugs tenofovir & emtricitabine
- Take ONE truvada tablet ONCE daily
- Truvada is usually taken with food

#### **Isentress**

- Take ONE Isentress tablet TWICE daily approx. 12 hours apart
- There are no food restrictions with this drug
- Avoid taking multivitamons, calcium/magnesium supplements and antacids
- Tablets should be swallowed whole (not chewed, broken or crushed)

### **Side effects**

Side effects with both Truvada and Isentress are generally mild. Some patients may experience:

- Mild headache
- Feel nauseous
- Stomach cramps
- Rash
- Tiredness
- Diarrhoea
- Vomiting
